Our Commitment

We support a culture where concerns can be raised in good faith and investigated fairly, confidentially and promptly.

What You Can Report

Examples include:

- Safeguarding concerns
- Fraud or financial misconduct
- Bribery or corruption
- Serious breaches of health and safety
- Discrimination or harassment
- Data protection breaches
- Modern slavery or labour exploitation
- Serious professional misconduct
- Criminal activity

How to Raise a Concern

You can report concerns by contacting Ag Eunice Care using our published contact details or by notifying your usual company contact. Please provide as much factual information as possible to assist any investigation.

Confidentiality

We will handle concerns sensitively and, where possible, protect the identity of the person raising the concern. Information will only be shared where necessary to investigate the matter or where required by law.

Protection from Retaliation

No person who raises a genuine concern in good faith will be subjected to retaliation, victimisation or unfair treatment because they have spoken up.

Our Response

We assess each concern, investigate where appropriate, take corrective action when required, and use lessons learned to improve our services and governance.
